As our client's are likely aware, WSIB union members are on strike. The Board has provided **News Release** updates since the union first issued the strike notice on May 21, 2025 on its website [here](#). The most recent update of [May 26, 2025](#) outlines how employers and workers can reach the Board (online) or by phone (however non urgent inquiries and services are expected to experience delayed responses). The Board's [services update page](#) advises how the strike action is impacting its services – including appeals scheduled during this time, objection time limits, scheduled worksite meetings and claim file access.

This is an interesting time for WSIB. There has never been a strike of the WSIB employee union members. In the past, the WSIB has maintained very cordial relations with its bargaining units and pursued differences in a "we're all in the same boat" mindset. This has been the approach since the Board was unionized over the past 40 or so years.
