Good morning,

Further to our note of June 5, 2025, there have been some updates with respect to the WSIB strike.

On Monday June 9, 2025 the Board provided an update advising: "The Workplace Safety and Insurance Board (WSIB) engaged in mediated talks with the Ontario Compensation Employees Union (OCEU) all weekend, advancing proposals on key topics like wages, benefits, and workload" noting that they await "a meaningful response from the union" See the full news release here.

On Tuesday, June 10, 2025 the OCEU/CUPE 1750 released an article titled WSIB quietly confirms backlog and costly shortcuts as strike nears third week, union says which outlines the details of a Board internal memo to WSIB staff over the weekend which announced temporary adjudication changes to "help manage the volume of claims during the labour disruption." The article can be found here.

The two sides are talking and the union awaits a response to an offer it submitted to the Board on Wednesday night, as per a <u>June 12, 2025 CTV news report.</u>

A June 13, 2025 article indicates that the issues are narrowing and while tensions remain high talks continue through a provincial mediator. The union was expecting a counteroffer from the WSIB on Friday (see article here).
